Every semester, please:

STUDENT: ASSEMBLE/REVIEW PRIOR TO MEETING

2. List of relevant courses you have taken before coming to UC Berkeley. Students provide a brief (1-3

sentence each) description of courses.

3. Review ESPM coursework guidelines.

4. List the courses you have taken at UC Berkeley as a graduate student (include course number, name
semester taken, and credit hours).

5. List classes you are thinking of taking next semester (include course number, name, semester taken, and credit hours).

6. What are the rough topics you hope to pursue in your dissertation research, and what analytical tools do you think you will use (e.g. biostatistics, GIS, phylogenetics, surveys)?

7. What topics do you wish to learn about in relation to your qualifying exam (qualifying exams typically cover at least four topics)? List the topics and how you think it relates to your dissertation plan and/or research interests.

8. Review suggestions for talking points

9. If applicable (domestic and permanent residents), review and start/continue the process to establish residency



GUIDING PROFESSOR PROVIDES INPUT AT MEETING:

Meet with your research mentor virtually prior to arriving on campus. In a shared google doc, have the faculty provide input on:

- Recommended classes and evaluation of previous UC Berkeley coursework (see below)
- What advice was given for areas to cover in the qualifying exam (QE), and QE preparation?
- Describe the student's dissertation plans and progress.
- Recommendations for the student as they are beginning their dissertation research
- Suggestions for QE or guiding committee members?
- Any recommendations for grants/fellowships the student should pursue this next year?
- Any recommendations for conferences the student could attend/present at?
